Preliminary note



- This rates record refers to the year 2018 and is based on the legislation of the Verpackungsverordnung (Packaging Ordinance).
- The reference value is the volume that entered the systems. As a result, the system participation also determines the actual recovery volume. Since system participation in 2018 was still unsatisfactory, a recovery rate of > 100% was achieved for plastics.
- With both recovery quotas and system participation on the rise, an increase of almost 100% in recovered volumes is necessary in 2019 to reach the quota for that year.
- In the case of paper/paperboard/cardboard packaging (PPC), 100% was recovered but not necessarily recorded. Only this year were the outdated expert opinions on the packaging share in paper collection renewed. Going forward, the corresponding records must be based on these new opinions.
